

A Very Festive Author Event

This week, our Key Stage 2 children began their in-school festive celebrations with a very special digital author event where they were introduced to the brand new short stories collection: *The Very Merry Murder Club*. During the event, the children participated in three very special panels with 8 of the authors from the book looking at how to create amazing settings for their own stories, how to craft interesting characters and how to plot a story whilst adding suspense. In between each panel, Harry Woodgate, the illustrator of the book, took the children through two special step-by-step guides for how to draw a setting and character which convey the mood of the story.

Phonics & Early Reading Update Parent Information

Our children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 have all made an excellent start to their early reading and phonics work. We are incredibly proud of everything they have achieved so far.

Our Year 2 children have all undertaken their Phonics Screening Check and have demonstrated excellent progress. I am incredibly pleased to announce that

93%

of our Year 2 children have passed their phonics screening check which is a fantastic achievement. What's even more impressive is our children averaged a pass score of 35.3 which is comfortably above the pass mark of 32. The table below demonstrates just how well our children have done compared to pupils nationally. Myself and Mr Peoples would like to send a huge thank you to everyone who has been involved in our Year 2 children's early reading journey, including the Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 teachers and support staff as well as all the support the Y2 pupils have received at home. You have all made an invaluable contribution to our children's education and by giving them such a strong start in reading, we are able to open the world up to them and have made a huge difference to the rest of their lives.


We Love Books!
