A welcome return of some sunshine at the end of a rainy week has seen us all smiling in school! Just a reminder that we do follow OPAL's principles of playing outdoors in most weathers and would like children to come with waterproofs and wellies to wear at break and lunchtimes please.

Due to the demand for after school club places, we are no longer able to operate a no-charge cancellation policy. Going forward, please can parents cancel their bookings at least 24 hours in advance of the session otherwise you will be still charged the full price for the booking even if your child didn't attend.

Please can parents avoid parking on Upwell Road or our school access road/car park. There is a grace period in Applegarth Car Park which means that parents can use spaces without charge during drop off and pick up times.


There are only 8 weeks left of the appeal so please help while you can!






